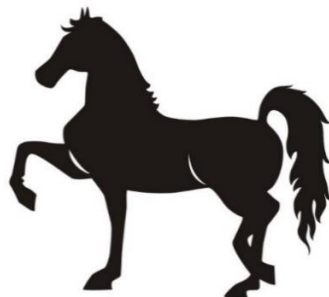

2. M & M Small Breeds Open Any Age Stallion, Mare & Geldings In-hand Shetland, Exmoor, Dartmoor, Welsh A & B.
3. M & M Large Breeds Open Any Age Stallion, Mare & Geldings New Forest, Fell, Dale, Highland, Connemara, Welsh C & D.
4. Rare/Foreign/World Breeds In-hand
5. VHS Pre- Veteran In-hand (15-19 years and over) Open to horses & ponies of any breed & height
6. VHS Veteran In-hand (20 -24 years and over) Open to horses & ponies of any breed & height
7. VHS Diamond Veteran In-hand (25 years and over) Open to horses & ponies of any breed & height
8. Best Turned Out Ridden 4 yrs & over Riders any age.

19. CHAPS (UK) Open Ridden Qualifier Any height, any Type.
20. TGCA Senior Open In-hand Open to Stallions, Mares & Geldings 4 yrs old & over any height, Open to all traditional gypsy cobs, which are of any colour and meet the TGCA breed standard.
21. TGCA Youngstock In-hand, Colt, Fillies or Geldings 1, 2, & 3 year olds, Open to all traditional gypsy cobs, which are of any colour and meet the TGCA breed standard.
22. TGCA Ridden 4 yrs old & over any height, Open to all traditional gypsy cobs, which are of any colour and meet the TGCA breed standard.
23. TGCA Quest Championship for the top 3 in classes 25-27.
24. In-hand Open Show Pony/Show Hunter Pony type any age not exc 148cms.

Open to members and non-members. All competitors and grooms must adhere to VHS Rules in all circumstances. Failure to do so may result in immediate disqualification.

VHS Regional Final qualification. All competitors placed 1st to 4th in each Area Qualifier class will qualify for the corresponding class at VHS Regional Finals. Members must have their showing card signed by the judge in the ring as proof of qualification. Non-members

will receive a red qualification card which can be exchanged for signed showing card when applying for VHS membership.

Regional Finals are open to members only.

All competitors are eligible to enter open classes at the National Veteran Open Championships,

29th September – 1st October 2017. No qualification or membership necessary. See VHS website for schedule.

T.G.C.A.

These classes are qualifiers for the Best of Breed Finals at the Traditional Gypsy Cob Association's (TGCA) National Breed Championship Show "TOYS" held annually in August. Full details can be obtained from [www.tgca.co.uk.Classes](http://www.tgca.co.uk.Classes) are open to all traditional gypsy cobs. Stallions –All stallions (four years and over) in order to enter any TGCA affiliated class, must be licensed with the TGCA prior to the show AND have their TGCA stallion disc displayed on their bridle. Existing TGCA members must present their qualification card to the judge in the ring for signature. Non-members will receive a qualification card from the judge and will have 21 days to join the TGCA and to register their horse in order to validate this. TOYS Qualifications will be awarded to the top three Youngstock. small senior IH. large senior IH. small ridden. large ridden and to the highest placed junior and restricted exhibitor. Please refer to [www.tgca.co.ukfor](http://www.tgca.co.ukfor) further details including membership. horse registration and showing rules (contained within the members' handbook). Competitors taking up membership from qualifying at this show will receive 2017 membership.

C.H.A.P.S.

This show is affiliated to The Coloured Horse & Pony Society (UK). Affiliation No. 17227 Both owner and the rider/exhibitor need not be a member of CHAPS (UK) nor must the horse or pony be registered with CHAPS (UK) to compete. However, in order to Qualify both Owner and Rider/Exhibitor need to be a current showing member and present their valid Qualifier card IN THE RING for signing by the judge. Members to apply in writing to CHAPS (UK) for appropriate qualifier card. The CHAPS (UK) Championship Show will be held on 30th August – 2nd September 2017. Shows held on or after the closing date of Championship Show will count as 2018 qualifiers. The following classes are CHAPS (UK) Qualifiers [Show Secretary to insert class numbers]. All stallions, 4 years old and over entering these classes must be graded with CHAPS (UK). All stallions must wear Stallion ID Discs in the ring without exception.

B.P.S ( British Palomino Society) This show is a qualifier for the BPS 2017 Cream of the Crop Championships. The series and final is open to all, there is no need for membership or registration with BPS. Qualification – the 2 highest placed Cream Dilutes in the qualifying classes go through to the final (Please note horses that are true Duns are not eligible as they are not a cream dilute). The final will be held at the BPS National Championships at The Three Counties Showground on 9th July 2017. ESUK This show is affiliated to Equine Sports UK (ESUK) Grassroots Championships taking place at Arena UK, Grantham, Lincolnshire on 3rd-6th August 2017, The 3 highest placed

Qualifying Rules

This show is a qualifier for the South West Pony Association Championships

to be held on 31 August - 3 September 2017,

at The David Broome Event Centre, Crick, Gwent

To qualify for the Championships:

1. Enter one of the qualifying classes.
2. Be one of the two highest placed exhibits not already qualified within the first four and receive a qualification card signed in the ring.
3. Complete the entry form on the qualification card.
4. Return the card to together with any registration fees due within 14 days of this show.

Please Note:

Registration fee for 2017 is £30 to include all members of the family and equines owned by the family.

T.S.R. TSR Showing Finals - This show is a qualifier for the 2017 TSR Showing Finals. Qualify and enter ANY of the Finals Central, East Anglia, North West, North East, South East, South, Wales & South West or Scottish. You Do Not have to be a TSR member to qualify or enter a final. The Rider/Handler qualifies and can enter any horse/pony in any number of Finals!

TSR Riders Finals - 1st & 2nd riders qualify and will receive a qualification card in the ring.

TSR In Hand Finals - The two highest placed Handlers with a TSR In Hand Card will qualify in any In Hand class. Handlers MUST have their cards signed in the ring by the judge/steward, cards are available FREE from the TSR website. Full details at
